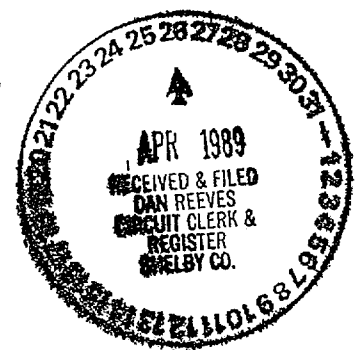

MOTION TO REVOKE BAIL

Comes now the State of Alabama, by and through its lawful Assistant District Attorney Robert E. Owens, Jr., and moves this Honorable Court to grant the above styled Motion. As grounds in support of this Motion, the State sets out the following:

1. That in January 1988, the Grand Jury of Shelby County indicted Ronald Patrick Swiney for Capital Murder, to which the defendant has pled not guilty and not guilty by reason of mental disease or defect.

2. That in order to have this defendant examined based upon his claim of lack of mental capacity he must be within the custody of the Shelby County authorities.

3. Taylor Hardin Mental Facility will make the required and requested examination within these perimeters.

The State therefore request this Honorable Court revoke the defendant Patrick Swiney's bond and order that he undergo testing at Taylor Hardin Mental Facility based upon his plea of not guilty by mental disease or defect.
