FINAL JUDGMENT


On June 23, 1998 the magistrate judge's findings and recommendation was entered and the parties were allowed therein fifteen (15) days in which to file objections to the recommendations made by the magistrate judge. On July 9, 1998 respondents filed objections to the magistrate judge's findings and recommendation. On July 15, 1998 petitioner filed a Motion Requesting Service of Report by Magistrate.
