Your Honor:

Thank you for setting the hearing to consider my **Amended Notice to Seek Expungement** on August 20, 2010. I worked hard and traveled a long way to subpoena my three witnesses and I worked hard to be prepared to present my case in court. Although I was again denied the chance to present my side of the story, I am most grateful for the outcome of the hearing and for your signed **ORDER** granting me expungement from my September 25, 2001 arrest.

Some months ago I attempted to appeal your order of February 25, 2010 on everything except the expungement claim, but since the order did not dispose of all the claims this appeal was premature and dismissed for lack of jurisdiction.

Now that a final judgment has been issued I should have the right to pursue my right to have an impartial jury hear all the evidence in this case and render a decision.
