

On **Wednesday, November 3, 2010, at 1:30 p.m.**, a calendar call will be held at the Cherokee County Justice Center, Courtroom 2C, for cases to be tried before the Hon. N. Jackson Harris for the **one week beginning Monday, November 15, 2010 – November 19, 2010.**

### READY LIST

Attached are **portions** of the civil calendar in which you are shown as counsel of record. The complete calendar is the **READY LIST** and is available for review in the Judge's Office or the Clerk of Superior Court Office. This is your notice of same pursuant to Rule 8.2(A), Uniform Superior Court Rules.

### CALENDAR CALL

Cases will be sounded and prioritized at Calendar Call. Unless ordered otherwise, cases will be tried in the order in which they appear on the calendar. Jury will have priority over non-jury trials and, in some instances, cases may be specially scheduled at a time other than trial week. In all cases, Counsel of Record must be present for announcement unless announcement in writing has been received by the Court prior to Calendar Call with certification that a copy has been served on opposing counsel/party. Telephone messages to Calendar Clerk or other Court personnel will not suffice and facsimiles are not accepted by the Court.

### PRE-TRIAL ORDER

A proposed **Consolidated Pre-Trial Order**, pursuant to Rule 7.2, Uniform Superior Court Rules, **including proposed domestic relations pre-trial orders in divorce cases**, shall be provided to the Court by all parties in every case prior to Calendar Call. Where the parties are unable to propose a consolidated pre-trial order, a pre-trial conference may be scheduled by agreement or as directed by the Court. If a consolidated pretrial order has not been proposed by the call of the calendar or a pretrial conference has not been scheduled, the Court will review the circumstances and the appropriate priority of the case in view of such circumstances.

### CONTINUANCES:

MOTIONS FOR CONTINUANCE, INCLUDING CONSENT MOTIONS, MUST BE IN WRITING, FILED AND CONSIDERED FOLLOWING THE CALL OF THE CALENDAR. COUNSEL WILL FURNISH THE COURT WITH A COURTESY COPY OF ANY MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE PRIOR TO CALENDAR CALL. THE COURT WILL NOT CONSIDER MOTIONS FOR CONTINUANCE OF ANY CASE ANNOUNCED READY FOR TRIAL, EXCEPT FOR A SHOWING OF LEGAL AND PROVIDENTIAL CAUSE.

CONSENT MOTIONS FOR CONTINUANCE AFTER THE CALL OF THE CALENDAR MUST INCLUDE THE AGREEMENT AND WRITTEN ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF THE PARTIES.

CASES CONTINUED BY CONSENT AFTER THE CALENDAR CALL AND AFTER HAVING ANSWERED READY AT THE CALENDAR CALL WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE JURY TRIAL CALENDAR UNTIL SUCH TIME AS BOTH PARTIES STIPULATE THE CASE FOR JURY TRIAL.

WITHDRAWING THE JURY DEMAND IN A CASE WILL NOT REMOVE THE CASE FROM THE TRIAL CALENDAR.

### MOTIONS

All motions must be filed and pending motions must be scheduled for hearing no later than Calendar Call. A predicate for hearing any motion after Calendar Call (including Motions in Limine) must be a satisfactory showing of why it could not have been filed and heard before Calendar Call.
