Dear Mr. Martin:

With regards to your letter of April 7, 2010, I was attempting to file an **Amended Argument for Appeal and Response to Order on Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings** to correct errors in the **Argument for Appeal and Response to Order on Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings** that had already been filed and a copy sent to the appellate court. I sent the **Amended Argument and Response to Order on Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings** to the Clerk of Superior Court of Cherokee County to file an amended document with the court and to be forwarded on to the Georgia Court of Appeals. I recently received a filed copy of my amended argument by U. S. mail and learned that it had been filed in the Superior Court of Cherokee County on April 6, 2010.

All of my documents include a Certificate of Service and are mailed to the opposing counsel. When sending a legal document I place my Certificate of Service at the end of the document. In fact the document I received back from you had a Certificate of Service on the last page of said document, but apparently you did not see it.

I was sent a letter from Deputy Clerk M. Bergman by Certified Mail on March 17, 2010 demanding \$698.00 in 20 days or my appeal could be dismissed. I had mailed a Pauper's Affidavit on March 10, 2010 and had not received a filed copy back from the court at the time of said March 17, 2010 letter and was forced to amend my appeal and reduce the size of documents sent to the Georgia Court of Appeals for fear that my case would not be forwarded to the Georgia Court of Appeals. I have lost my custom home that I personally designed and built and I have lost hundreds of thousands of dollars in cash and assets fighting for justice in

this case and now I struggle financially. My Pauper's Affidavit was granted by Judge Miller confirming the unethical and unlawful actions by the Cherokee County Court.

I have sent **Notice of Supplemental Record** on my case by U. S. Mail on April 12, 2010, with a Certificate of Service, to the Clerk of Cherokee County Superior Court. I have also included your name and address on the Certificate of Service for a copy to be sent to the Georgia Court of Appeals. As required by law I will file a brief, including as Part II an Enumeration of Errors, within 20 days of docketing. I may also request an oral argument and I will notify the appellate court of this request.

Sir, all I am asking is to be granted a trial by an impartial jury to hear the facts of this important case which could have far reaching impact, and I am requesting such now.
