Part A—INMATE REQUEST This Grievance Concerns Warden Charlie Jones and Assistant Warden R.L.

Mothershed knowingly, intentionally and maliciously exposing older sick, handicapped and less than healthy inmates to completely needless suffering and a known dangerous environment. That by failing to provide or establish housing to protect older inmates from being victimized by much younger and aggressive and abusive inmates, they display a complete indifference to a known danger. That by forcing the older and handicapped inmates out doors for several hours refusing to post guards, or any type of security; exposing the inmates to known harsh and dangerous elements, again unequivocally the display of deliberate indifference to the health, well ness suffering and life threatening situations. That when verbal complaints are expressed concerning such dangers and needless suffering they refuse to confront and address or even discuss such blatant violations of needless abuse and known violations of Human rights as well as rights guaranteed under the United States Constitution. That they refuse to help secure or attempt to secure basic medical needs and proper and adequate medical treatment for said inmates, a total display of deliberate indifference. That both Mr Charlie Jones and Mr R.L. Mothershed are fully and completely aware of these well established rights inalienable ones. Yet with such deliberate indifference to human life and suffering and with thier evil intent they refuse to conform to thier sworn statutory duties under the laws of the State of Alabama and the Constitution of the United States of America.
